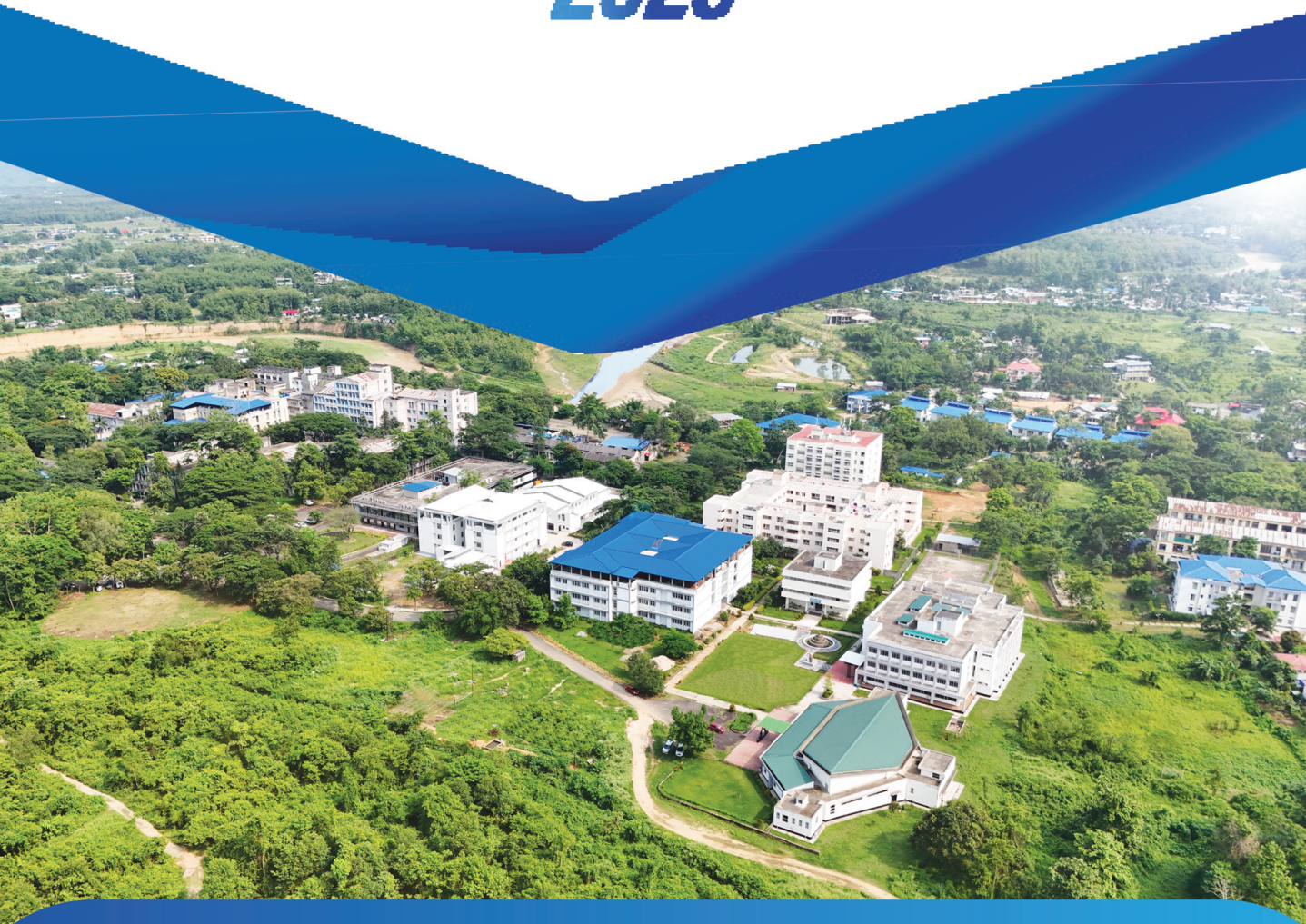

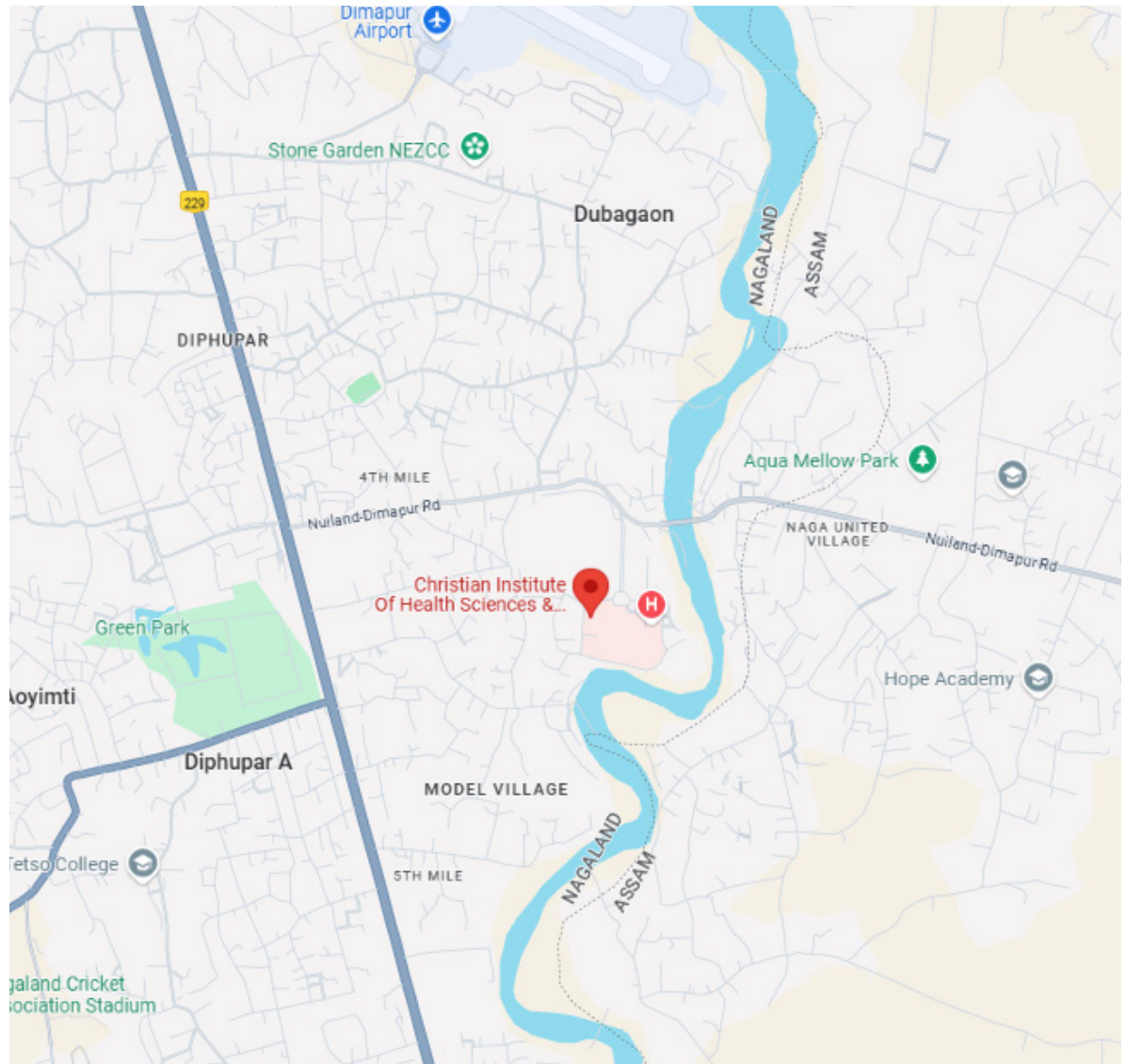

CMC Vellore contributes significantly by way of training opportunities, regular visits by consultants, information transfer and advice. Selection and Preference Guidelines for NERMPI Programs:

A candidate shall separately choose maximum of three programs in NERMPI in the order of their preferences. If a candidate is applying for two or more programs, they must indicate their choices in the order of preferences. If a candidate gets selected for two or three of the programs, they will be allowed to join the program of their highest preference. If a candidate is on the waiting list of the first program, and is selected for the second choice, they may move from the second choice to the first choice, subject to seat being subsequently available.

Selection Will Be Based On Merit

Entrance test will be conducted for all eligible applicants by the institution for all programs. The questions will be based on both 10th and 12th standard syllabus of the Nagaland Board of School Education for GNM & Degree programs and for Post Basic B.Sc. the questions will be based on GNM syllabus.

The Entrance test for NERMPI Degree programs will be computer based. The shortlisted candidates will be called for interview and medical test.

The Entrance test for the College of Nursing programs will be conducted for all eligible applicants.

1. GNM: Written exam will be based on 10th standard science
2. B.Sc. Nursing: Written exam will be based on the 12th standard Physics Chemistry Biology syllabus of the Nagaland Board of School Education.
3. PBBSC and One-year Diploma courses: Written exam will be based on the five specialty subjects.

Note: A candidate applying for BOTH GNM & B.Sc. Nursing MUST APPEAR in both the written examinations.

4. The shortlisted candidates will be called for Practical test, Interview and Medical Test.

APPLICATION FEES:

The candidate applying for a course will pay ₹1700 (₹1200+₹500) as mentioned above. However, if a candidate desires to apply for more than one course, one has to pay an amount of ` 500 for each of the additional course applied (Nursing or NERMPI programs).

A candidate can choose a maximum of three courses under NERMPI and two courses under College of Nursing.

For Example:

- If you are applying for the GNM program, the application fee is ` 1700 (₹1200+ ₹500 = ₹1700).
- If you also wish to apply additionally for BSc. Nursing and BSc. MLT (NERMPI), an additional fee of ` 500 each will levy. In this case, the total payable amount will be ₹2700 (₹1700+ ₹500+₹500=₹2700).

Candidate must apply online through our website www.cihsr.in

1. Read the prospectus carefully and determine whether you meet all the requirements for admission.
2. Documents to be uploaded along with the duly filled Application Form:
 - a. Self-attested photocopy of Mark sheet of class X
 - b. Self-attested photocopy of Mark sheet of class XII (if available)
 - c. Passport sized photo: Upload in JPEG format
 - d. Screenshot of the application fee payment/softcopy of payment receipt as prescribed

Additionally, for Post Basic BSc Nursing

- e. Self-attested photocopy of GNM mark sheet issued by the examining board.

Medical Check-Up:

Students must register and pay online for a medical check-up at CIHSR Hospital. Medical fitness tests will be conducted after the entrance exam, before the interview day.

NORTH EAST REGIONAL MULTI-DISCIPLINARY PARAMEDICAL INSTITUTE, CIHSR

Affiliated to Nagaland University



On September 20, 2010, a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) was executed among the NEC, Government of Nagaland, and CIHSR to establish a Regional Institute of Allied Health Sciences in Dimapur, Nagaland. This initiative aimed to provide training for Health Sciences Professionals from Nagaland and other north-eastern states. Following this agreement, five diploma programs, in collaboration with the Christian Medical Association of India (CMAI) were introduced between 2011 and 2015. In 2019, NERMPI introduced three B.Sc. degree programs—Medical Lab Technology, Anaesthesia & Operation Theatre Technology, and Health Information Management—replacing the diploma courses in these fields. Two additional programs, B.Sc. in Radiotherapy Technology (recognized by the Atomic Energy Regulatory Board (AERB), Government of India) and Bachelor of Physiotherapy, were started in 2023. In 2024, NERMPI started B.Sc. in Medical Imaging & Radiology Technology (recognized by the Atomic Energy Regulatory Board (AERB), Government of India) and B.Sc. in Dialysis Therapy Technology, bringing the total number of courses to seven. The institute has also applied for a Bachelor of Occupational Therapy program, awaiting approval from Nagaland University, with plans to commence in the 2025-26 academic session. In December 2023, NERMPI was recognized as a separate college by Nagaland University, with its formal inauguration by the Chief Secretary to the Government of Nagaland on February 24, 2024.



PROGRAMS OFFERED UNDER NERMPI, CIHSR:

BACHELOR OF MEDICAL LABORATORY SCIENCES (BMLS)

This program is a comprehensive professional course designed to equip students with the necessary knowledge and skills to perform and excel in the field of medical laboratory science. This program provides a solid foundation in the theoretical and practical aspects of laboratory science, preparing students to effectively perform laboratory tests and analyse samples, including blood, urine, tissue, and other body fluids to aid in the diagnosis, treatment, and prevention of various diseases and medical conditions.

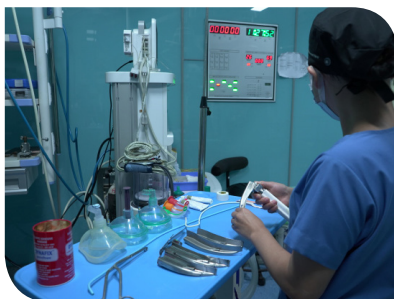

Opportunities for Higher Studies and Career Prospects for Graduates	Postgraduate and Doctoral degrees in Haematology, Biochemistry, Pathology, Microbiology, etc. There are excellent job opportunities for qualified medical laboratory technologists. They can work in hospitals, research laboratories, public health facilities, and industrial laboratories, manage their laboratory setup, teach and do research in academia, and pursue higher studies.

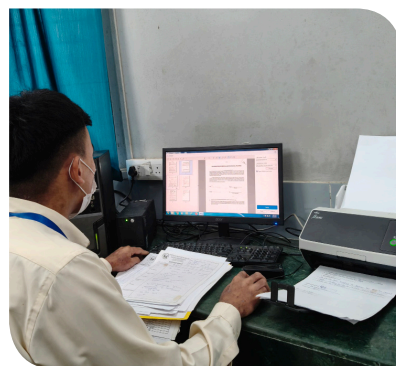
BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN ANAESTHESIA AND OPERATION THEATRE TECHNOLOGY (BSc. AOTT)

The program BAOTT aims to train individuals who will become competent in helping in various activities in the operation theatre, Intensive care units (ICU), and assisting anaesthetists in the safe delivery of anaesthesia. This program is designed to provide the students with a comprehensive overview of the basic clinical sciences, general clinical principles, operation theatre sterilization techniques, and ethics, ICUs and the emergency department, basics of anaesthetic management in specialties such as general surgery, obstetrics, paediatrics, orthopaedics, ENT, and Emergency & Trauma surgery and given ample practical experience in all these areas as most of the training is designed for on-the-job learning.

Duration of the program	3 Years + 1 Year mandatory internship
Core Subjects	Anatomy & Physiology, Clinical Pharmacology & Microbiology, Principles of Anaesthesia, Medicine related to Anaesthesia, Basics of surgery & Applied Microbiology (CSSD), Basic ICU Care, Anaesthesia for Specialty Surgeries, Research Methodology, Biostatistics, Quality and Patient Safety, Principles of basic nursing, Hospital Infection control.

Health Information Management deals with organizing, analysing, and securing medical data to ensure its accessibility and confidentiality for effective healthcare management and decision-making. Health Information Professionals serve as vital links, connecting various aspects of healthcare such as patient care, operations, and management.	
Duration of the program	3 Years + 1 Year mandatory internship

BACHELOR OF PHYSIOTHERAPY (BPT)

Physiotherapy as described by World Physiotherapy is a health care profession concerned with human function and movement and maximizing physical potential. Physiotherapy supports people of all stages of life from child to older age.

Duration of the program	4 Years + 6 Months mandatory internship
Core Subjects	Human Anatomy & Physiology, Pathology/Microbiology/Pharmacology, Biomechanics & Kinesiology, Code of ethics in physiotherapy, Exercise therapy & Electrotherapy, Physiotherapy in Orthopaedic/ Neurology/ Medical & Surgical/Cardio-Pulmonary/Paediatrics/ Sports, and Biostatistics & Research methodology.

BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN RADIOTHERAPY TECHNOLOGY (BSc. RTT) (Recognised by Atomic Energy Regulatory Board, Government of India)

The Radiotherapy Technology program provides specialized training for the treatment of cancer patients requiring radiation therapy. The program encompasses immobilization, imaging, and different treatment modalities, and ensures adherence to safety measures. It also involves maintaining detailed records of treatments and is responsible for the accurate delivery of radiation therapy. Due to the increasing number of cancer centres utilizing radiation therapy, there are significant employment opportunities in this field.

BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN MEDICAL RADIOLOGY & IMAGING TECHNOLOGY (BSc. MRIT)

(Recognised by Atomic Energy Regulatory Board, Government of India)

This program is designed to impart training and practical experience in taking X-rays of the human body, ultrasound examination, Computed Tomography (CT), and Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI). In addition, they are also trained in a variety of special procedures like Intravenous Urography, Barium studies, Hystero-salpingogram, ESWL (lithotripsy), etc. They are also exposed to interventional procedures, digital radiography, and the PACS System.

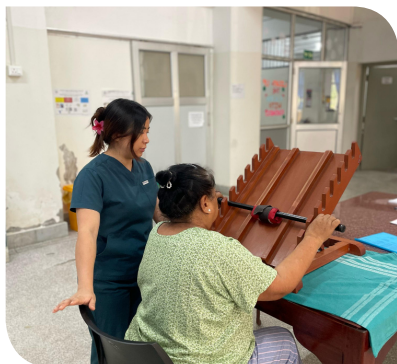

BACHELOR OF OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY (BOT)

The program aims to educate students to become healthcare professionals who assist individuals dealing with physical and mental difficulties, helping them to overcome obstacles and achieve independence. DIPLOMA IN HOSPITAL EQUIPMENT MAINTENANCE (DHEM)

Given the ever-changing nature of technology in the healthcare industry, ensuring the proper maintenance and calibration of equipment has become increasingly difficult. Consequently, engineers now require not only a thorough understanding of hospital equipment but also practical training in equipment maintenance. Therefore, this diploma program aims to train students with engineering backgrounds in the maintenance of equipment in hospitals.

GENERAL NURSING MIDWIFERY (GNM)

The General Nursing Midwifery (GNM) program is a 3-year course designed to develop competency in providing nursing care in hospitals or communities. Upon completion, students become licensed nurses proficient in patient care, teaching, administration, and leadership.

Duration of the Course: 3 years including internship.

Year 1: Fundamentals of Nursing, Biological and Behavioural Sciences, Computer Education, English, Community Health Nursing-I

Year2: Medical Surgical Nursing, Mental Health Nursing, and Child Health Nursing.

Year3: Obstetrics and Gynaecological Nursing, Community Health Nursing II, Nursing Education, Introduction to Research, Professional Trends, Nursing Administration, and Ward Management.

1. Pass at 10+2 passed in any stream preferably Science, (Physics, Chemistry, Biology) & English with aggregate of 40% marks.

BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN NURSING

The Basic B.Sc. Nursing program is a 4-year course, full-time curriculum consisting of eight semesters. It prepares graduates for nursing and midwifery roles in both public and private healthcare settings. Following a credit and semester system, the program includes foundational, core, and elective courses. Mandatory modular learning is integrated into all courses, with elective courses offering a choice-based system through modules.

Duration of the Course: 4 years including internship.

- 1st & 2nd Semester: Nursing Foundation, Nutrition, Biochemistry, Psychology, Anatomy, Physiology, Sociology, Health/Nursing Informatics & Technology, English.

- 5th & 6th Semester: Child Health Nursing, Mental Health Nursing, Educational Technology/ Nursing Education, Midwifery/Obstetrics and Gynaecology (OBG) Nursing, Community Health Nursing- I, Introduction to Forensic Nursing and Indian laws, Nursing Management & Leadership.
- 7th & 8th Semester: Midwifery & Obstetrics Nursing, Nursing Research & Statistics, Community Health Nursing –II & 6 months' Internship

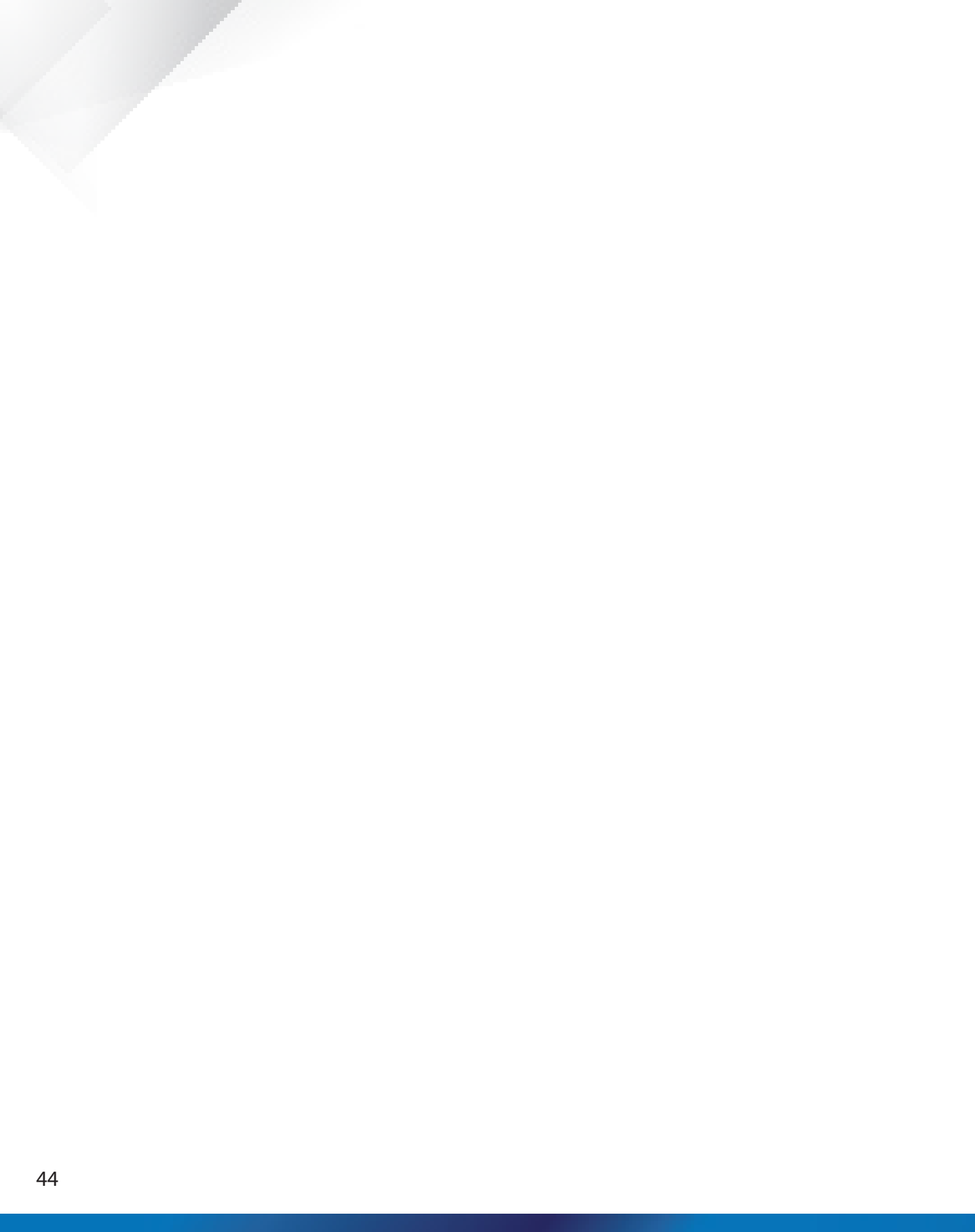
