Not currently taking antibiotics. A total of 23 students volunteered to donate blood, but after screening, only 14 were deemed eligible to donate.

World Immunization Day was observed on 9th of November, 2024 which aims to raise awareness among the public on the vital role vaccines play in preventing infectious disease and protecting public health.

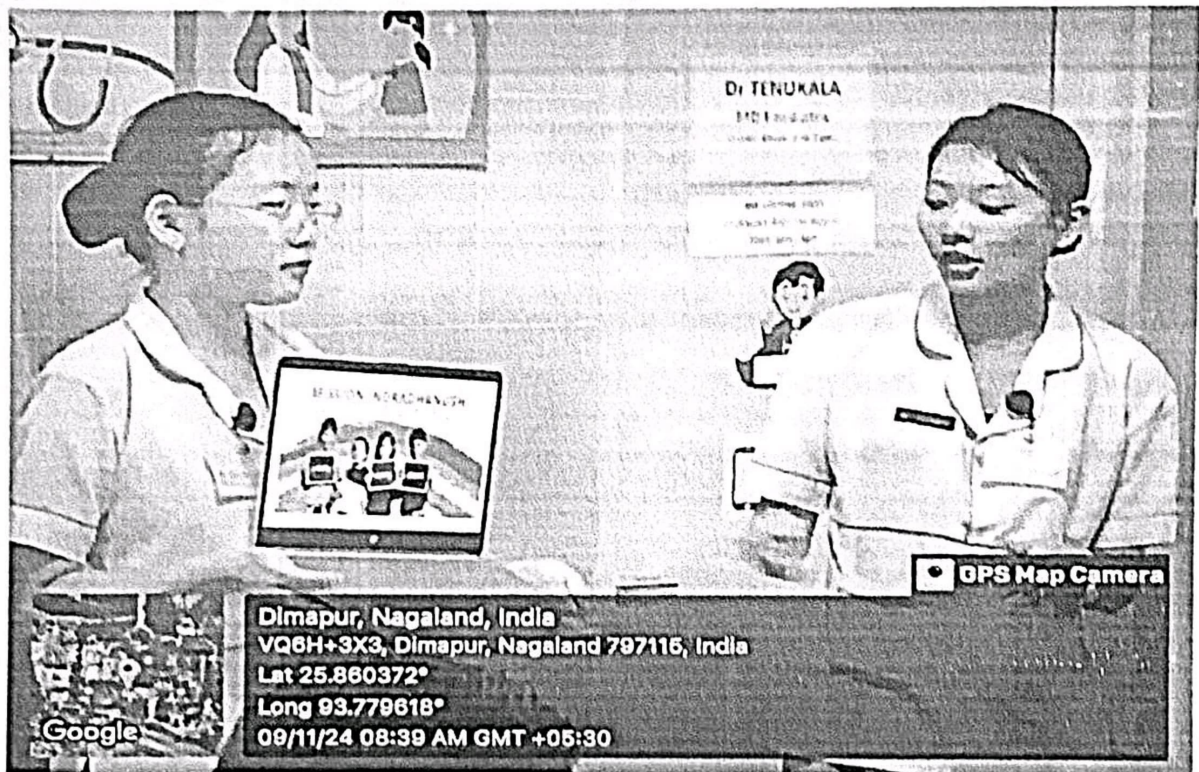


Figure 1: Student updating on mission indranush

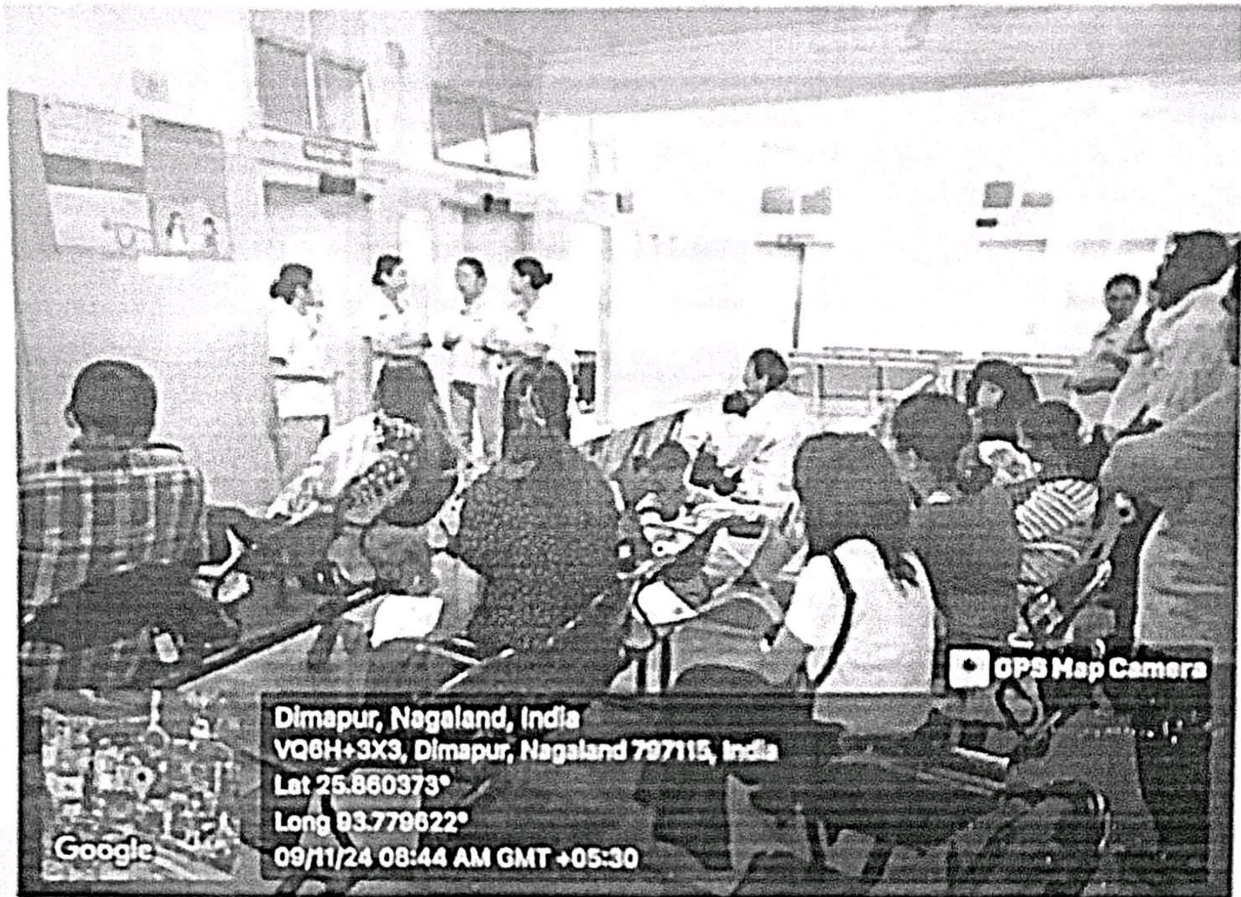


Figure 2: Students doing role play on importance of immunization

REPORT ON WORLD DIABETES DAY

World Diabetes Day is observed annually on November 14th, a date that marks the birthday of Sir Frederick Banting, who co-discovered insulin in 1921 alongside Charles Best. This day aims to raise awareness about diabetes, its prevention, and management, emphasizing the importance of a coordinated global response to this growing health crisis.

On account of World Diabetes Day on 14th November BscN 3rd semester Students Roll no 11-20 along with the incharge Ms. Esther Kent organized a role play on the theme, "Breaking Barriers, Bridging Gaps", in medicine ward, CIHSR where 8 to 10 patient attendant participated. The objectives on the role play generally included:

1. Raising Awareness: Educating the patient care giver about diabetes and its complications.
2. Promoting Healthy Lifestyles: Encouraging healthy eating, regular physical activity, and weight management to lower diabetes risk.
3. Access to Care: Advocating for equitable access to diabetes care and education, including access to medications and technologies.

Through the role play the students also so highlighted on the Current Challenges faced, despite growing awareness, several challenges remain such as:

1. Access to Care: Many individuals, particularly in low- and middle-income countries, still lack access to essential diabetes care and education.
2. Education: There remains a knowledge gap regarding diabetes management and prevention among the general population.
3. Stigma: People with diabetes may face stigma, impacting their mental health and willingness to seek help.

Conclusion

World Diabetes Day serves as a vital reminder of the global diabetes crisis and the importance of unified efforts to combat it. By raising awareness, facilitating access to information and care, and supporting research initiatives, stakeholders can help improve the quality of life for those living with diabetes and work towards reducing the burden of the disease worldwide. 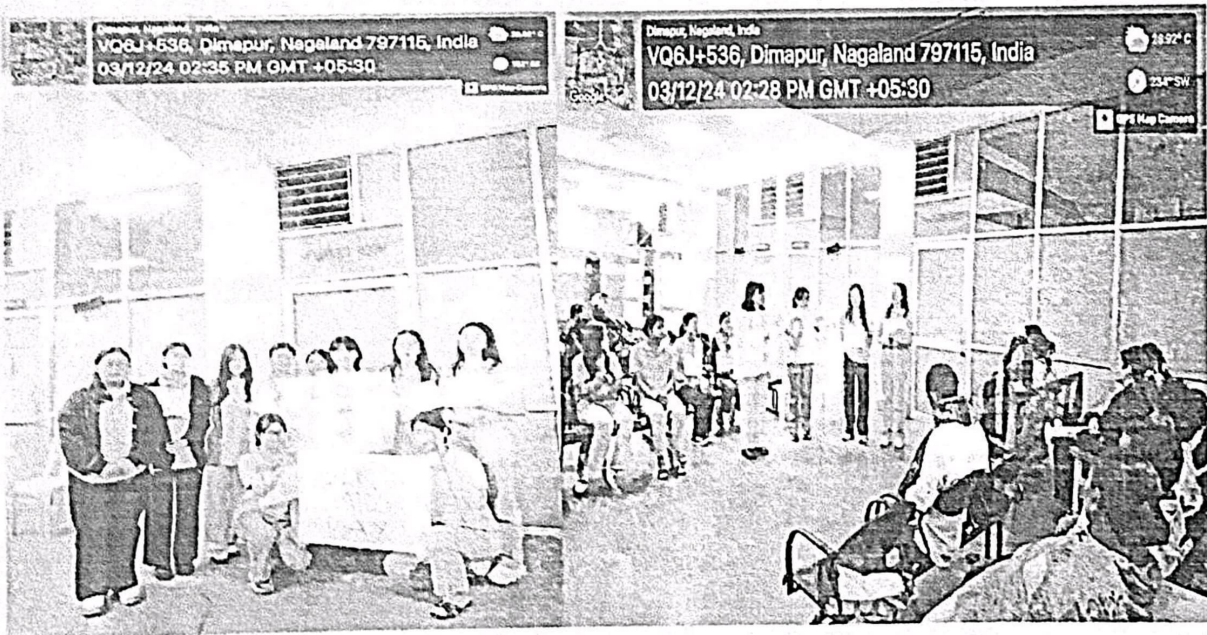

NATIONAL DEWORMING DAY: 10th FEBRUARY 20125

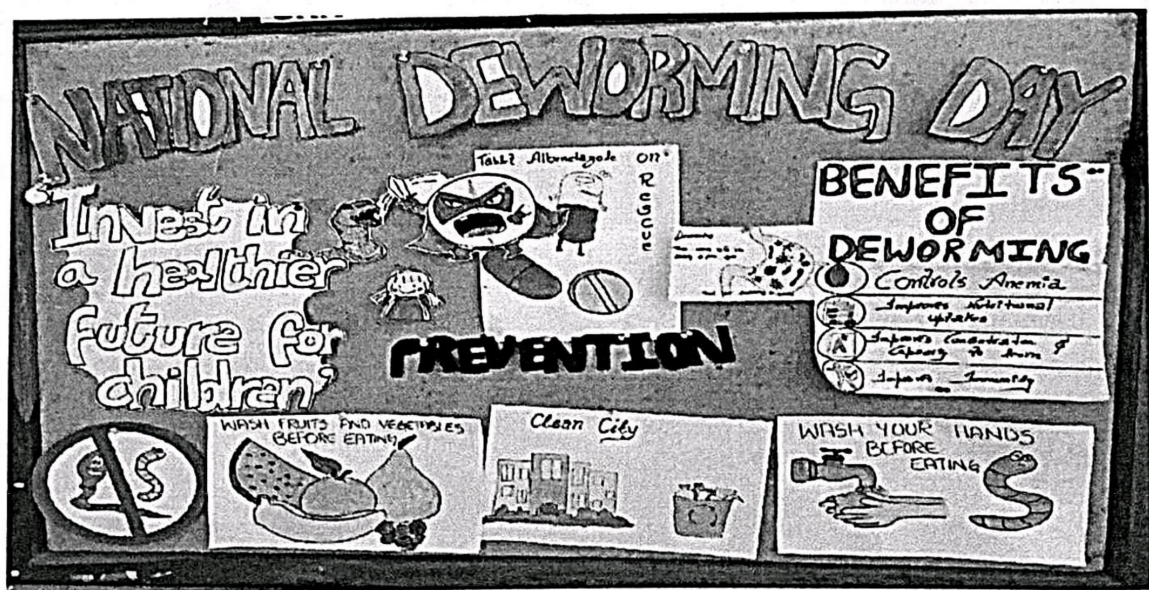
THEME: "TOGETHER WE CAN DEWORM OUR FUTURE"
